



The EU isn't our future; it's shrinking as a world player. The UK is already the world's 6th largest economy and a top 10 manufacturer.


Outside the EU, our economy could grow faster, creating more jobs.


The idea that 3m jobs would be risked by leaving the EU is just a big lie.

reckoned the EU costs us around £165 billion a year. That's bigger than the UK's budget deficit that George Osborne is struggling to fix. So if we cut out the costs of the EU, we could pass on a healthier economy to our children and grandchildren.

We can tell the European Court of Human Rights where to go.

The UK has a proud tradition of liberty and freedom. If we leave the EU, we can also withdraw from the European Court of Human Rights.

Then we can deport foreign criminals (even if they have a cat); we won't have to give votes to prisoners; and we can give whole-life sentences to the worst criminals.

We can TRADE with the world, not subsidise it.

The Conservatives, Labour and Liberal-Democrats (and Greens, SNP and Plaid Cymru) all want the EU to get bigger and bigger.

That's why they're already giving your money to countries like Turkey, Serbia, Albania, Armenia, Libya, the Ukraine...
